



Local 1271 Award Nomination Form

Any member of Local 1271 can nominate a fellow member or an individual for one of the following awards by filling out the nomination form and sending it to the Union Registrar. Nominations will be collected throughout the year up to July 12th of the presenting year, with the winners being announced at the annual Union awards night at the summer retirement BBQ.

Local 1271 Award Criteria

SPECIAL RECOGNITION: Individuals who have made a considerable contribution to the Surrey Fire Fighters in the last year.

COMMITTEE AWARD: An active member with a minimum 5 years of service who has participated on numerous committees or extended tenure on a single committee and has made a significant impact contributing to the betterment of all Local 1271 members for an extended period of time (a majority of their five years of service).

LORNE WEST AXE AWARD: An active member with a minimum of 10 years of service who has shown a dedicated and conscientious effort to uphold the standard of professionalism, reflects credit upon Local 1271 on and off duty, supports SFFCS initiatives in the community, and promotes goodwill among union brothers and sisters. They will have been contributing to the betterment of all Local 1271, members for a majority of their (ten years) service.

RED POWELL AWARD: The Fire fighters, FIRE FIGHTER. The recipient of this award should exemplify that of a conscientious and dedicated fire fighter. On duty and off duty, this is someone who upholds the standards of our profession, reflects credit upon Local 1271 and promotes goodwill among union brothers and sisters. The Red Powell recipient will be an active member and should have been a member of Local 1271 for 20 years or more. They will have contributed to not only the betterment of all Local 1271 members, but also to the people in the community which we serve. Local 1271 is proud of them as a member and they are proud to be a member.

Non Active Local 1271 Award Criteria

HONOURARY FIRE FIGHTER: An Honourary fire fighter is a member of the public who has contributed to the goals and objectives of Local 1271 and has shown the dedication and commitment required to be a fire fighter. They will have, by virtue of their efforts, provided Local 1271 with a positive profile in the public's eye and will have provided Local 1271 members a sense of pride. A strong sense of community will be evident in their actions and achievements on behalf of Local 1271.

LOCAL 1271 ALUMNI AWARD: A retired Local 1271 member who is contributing to the betterment of the Local 1271 Alumni and the betterment of Local 1271. This retired member will also be active with SFFCS, through SFFCS initiatives and community events.
